**Year-End Report – June 2022**

**Budget**

As of mid-May, a total of \$13.1 million was spent on Integration Aide and Special Education Technician allocations. As is now the regular practice, the funds were fully allocated to the schools at the start of the academic year.

**Provincial Entente 2020-2023**

The new provincial entente includes a number of appendices with new funding for special needs groupings and students. Despite this being a standing item from the beginning of the year, the committee has still not yet received the requested budgetary confirmations from the LBPSB.
