



Report of the Central Professional Improvement Committee (CPIC) Meeting of November 10, 2022

Review of DPIC, CC and Conference Budgets

As of October 2022: 11 New Teachers requests were approved. Over \$25,000 is left in the budget but it does not include the cost of substitution as CPIC can cover up to two days of substitution per request. 34 credit courses requests were approved, for a total of \$9,420. 53 PDA were approved for a total of \$27,162.45.

DPIC Budgets

DPIC have not received their official budget at the moment. Budgets are allocated based on full-time teacher equivalences (FTE).

New Teachers Funding

Substitution is included in the starting allocation set aside from the contingency fund, as voted at the last PTU AGM in June 2022.

Application Forms

It is important to note that application forms submitted with missing information or filled incorrectly may result in the PDA not being approved. A request was made in September, clarifications were asked in October and November but were not provided - the PDA was therefore refused.

Review of Requests

12 requests for credits courses were presented; 11 were approved. 1 was denied as the teacher had made the request last month for the maximum amount.

4 New Teachers requests were presented, and all were approved.

27 requests for professional development activities were presented and approved.

One Special Project was presented but information was missing. Approval is pending until the new request including clarifications is submitted.
