

Report of the Educational Policies Committee (EPC)**Meeting of December 12, 2022****Mozaik Update**

Four consultants: M. Gabe, S. Dunwoodie, S. Connery and B. Hanna will be trained and ready to assist teachers. The school board is deciding on the use of certain functionalities of Mozaik as there is a price tag attached to some specific aspects. The directorate pays for some options, but Educational Services is not aware of all functionalities implemented. Concerns and suggestions can be shared with EPC members - Matt Canavan will follow up with the directorate following questions being asked.

Ukrainian Student Support

Survey was sent to schools regarding what is needed in terms of resources for new students. The survey was sent to all consultants and to high school principals to send to all teachers with first-generation immigrants' students in their class.

Concerns were shared and a request was made to have all the links previously shared to teachers to be organized by level - J. Leblanc and E. Lamothe will work with MA Paquette to organize the resources to be given to teachers. There is also some funding which should be available to release some teachers to assist them with this task.

Term 2 Mark Submission Dates

ESD did not mandate any change of dates. At LBPSB we tend to want to have our second report card in for CEGEP applications. Conversation needs to happen at the administration meeting to decide if LBPSB wants to have one or two report cards for SRAM in the future.

Exam Schedules

The High School exam schedule should be out next week. Elementary schedule - only Ministry exams are mandated. ESD is encouraging schools to do them, but they are not obligated. A memo to administrators should go out in January.

Online Project in ContEd

Concerns were raised about the fact that the project was implemented before being brought up at EPC. PTU did not give their position on the project for the time being as it was not consulted prior to implementation. The item will remain on EPC and LRC meeting agendas for progress updates.

Upcoming Workshops

January 20, 2023 - all schools and teaching staff will be working on their educational projects. The work is to assess school identity, directions where they would like their school to be going - start the reflection process for the Fall. From September to December 2023, the schools will create their project to be in full effect by January 2024.
