Negotiations 2023

There has been very little progress at both levels of provincial negotiations. Our chief negotiator at QPAT continues to report that they seem to be speaking a different language than the employer's representatives when it comes to addressing our class composition and workload concerns.

Equally alarming is the tone coming from the intersectorial tables, which govern all public sector workers. The government has not improved their salary offer (it remains an unacceptable 9% over 5 years). Even more concerning are the government's proposals to change our pension plan to force workers to stay in the job market longer. You may see the latest INFO-NEGO from the Common Front here to see what the impact of these proposals would be. In short, these are absolutely unacceptable, and the Treasury Board has been told as much.

We will need to send a strong message to the government in the fall. Please mark your calendars: a major Common Front demonstration is being planned on **Saturday, September 23** starting at Jeanne-Mance Park in Montreal. The Common Front is aiming for 100 000 participants!

You should also anticipate a call to a general assembly in late September or early October regarding potential strike action. More information will be shared in due course, but you may read about the current context at the intersectorial bargaining tables here.

Strike action is certainly a last resort... all the more reason to join us on September 23 in Montreal!

To end on a more positive note, our now-retired former colleague Ann Granger takes part in a dragon boat team for breast cancer survivors: they are always looking for new team members! <u>More information</u> may be found here if interested.
