University of Sherbrooke Brevet for Vocational Teachers

University of Sherbrooke will start offering the Brevet program for Vocational Teachers in English as of January 2024. Vocational teachers can ask for credit courses reimbursement according to the CPIC guidelines.

Info-Session Workshop

The presentation took place via Zoom: 27 participants attended with one administrator present. The feedback received from the participants was positive and questions were answered at the end of the meeting.

Review of Budget 2023-2024

Here are the budgets including up to October 2023.

11 Networks have been accepted; no more applications will be accepted for this school year as the budget is depleted.

1 Special Project was accepted for a reimbursement of \$4,076.11. Initial funding for this school year was \$100,000.

33 requests were made for credit courses reimbursements for a total of \$10,990.

51 teachers were approved to attend a Professional Development Activity (PDA) for a total of \$29,335.41.

23 New Teachers were approved for a total of \$51,616.82.

Review of Requests

7 requests for New Teachers Professional Development Activities were presented: 6 were approved and one was denied as the teacher had applied and was approved in the past two years for a New Teacher PDA.

15 requests for PDA were presented and all were approved.

2 Special Projects were presented for Allion and Sunshine Elementary schools.

3 Network requests were presented and denied as the funds have been exhausted.

6 credit courses requests were presented and approved.
