## **BUSINESS ARISING**

Workloads:

PTU has yet to receive a copy of all the teacher workloads.

Retirees Returning to the Workforce:

The school board has two remaining corrections to retirees' pays in ContEd.

Refrigeration STC:

The refrigeration STC began on January 31st with 22 students. I am told things are going well.

## STANDING ITEMS

Mentoring:

The school board is exploring a different way of distributing the mentoring allocation (in vocational training only) for next year in order to better assist the Health and Construction sectors' needs. More information will be shared when a concrete plan is in place.

Next meetings: April 3rd and May 15th, 2024.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

As mentioned verbally at the last meeting, here is the information for the *Plan de Rattrapage*: 15026 volet 1 (tutoring) - \$100,000 which will be divided equally among 7 centres (WICC will manage the student needs for PCVC).

These monies will be spent on activities such as remediation (outside of already scheduled activities), tutoring (outside of class time), second teacher in the classroom.

Teachers are selected at the Centre Director's discretion and acceptance is on a voluntary basis. Teachers that do participate will be paid at the 1/1000th rate.

15026 volet 4 (perseverance) - \$95,000 which will be divided equally among 7 centres (WICC will manage the student needs for PCVC)
