



Report of the Central Professional Improvement Committee (CPIC) Meeting of November 14, 2024

CPIC Info-Session

The info-session took place on Zoom; 40 participants were in attendance including Chairpersons of DPIC Committees and administration.

Starting Budget 2024-2025 School Year

Budget was received and is based on Full-Time Equivalencies (FTE) for teachers in each school and centre.

CPIC keeps 38% of the budget at the Central Table; schools and centres receive 62% of the budget based on their FTEs.

CPIC budget for the 2024-2025 school year is as follows :

- Professional Development Activities: \$108,845
- Credit Courses Budget: \$36,162
- Network Allocation \$80,000
- Special Projects: \$80,000
- New Teachers' Budget: \$80,000

Review of requests

- 16 credit courses requests were presented; all were approved.
- 27 requests were presented by teachers to attend a PDA; all were approved.
- 7 New Teachers requests were presented; all were approved.
- 2 Elementary Schools (Allion and Dorset) presented Special Project requests; both were approved.
- 1 Network request was presented; it was approved.
