DELEGATES' REPORT – JANUARY 2026

RETIRED SUBSTITUTES AND LOCAL BUDGETS

To solve the problem of repayment for the difference between retired substitute costs and regular substitute costs only being remitted after the school year is over, schools may go over their local budgets by the same amount as the difference they are paying retired substitutes. This will involve detailed tracking by the school office and School Council or committee chairpersons, but to date, this is the best solution we have. Principals have already been given this information.

STAFFING

Staffing season 2026-2027 is beginning! The staffing timeline will be posted by February 1, 2026. The first dates to be aware of are:

February 2 – 20, 2026: 50-50 choice forms available.

February 2 – March 13, 2026: Requests for leaves of absence, sabbaticals, progressive retirements.

Only requests submitted using the appropriate form and by the specified deadline will be considered, so be sure to check SSO under Human Resources → Teachers Youth Sector.
