EVALUATION AND PEDAGOGY

MEQ Exam Schedule

The exam schedule has been set and is now available to all teachers. The Environmental Science exam will take place on June 15, prior to the Grade 10 science exam. This decision was made in partnership with the rest of the provincial network.

Student Evaluation Policy

Consultation on the proposed student evaluation policy will be launched shortly by the Council of Commissioners.

TEACHER TRAINING

Teacher Workshops

January 30th workshops went well, aside from those at Lakeside Academy having to be cancelled due to a lack of water in the building.

A concern was raised about repeating workshop topics when only one workshop is being offered in that subject area.

The Ministry of Education is requiring all teachers to participate in video workshops focused on anti bullying and anti-violence. The school board remade the videos with the permission of the MEQ to improve the quality of the training. The March 23rd workshops will be dedicated to this training, and will take place virtually at each school, while being centrally animated by the school board.

16 people from the LBPSB will be attending a conference in Vancouver on April 10th focused on evaluation, including many teacher participants who received funding from CPIC.

A request was made to investigate the use of Gemini directly within Google Classroom. Jason Cantelmi, Assistant Director of IT will investigate for us.
