Meeting of March 25, 2026**

Presentation:

There was a presentation on the pathways for secondary students.

Budget:

A vote on the budget consultation letter was had, and it was approved unanimously.

IEP Numbers:

Sandra Luther provided an update on IEP numbers, as follows:

- Students at risk or in difficulty: LD, MI, BD
- Students with social maladjustments or handicaps: 14, 23, 24, 33, 34, 36, 43, 44, 50, 53, 98 and 99

2025-2026:

- 1582 students in difficulty
- 1439 students with a handicap code
- 16.24% of the LBPSB population

Kindergarten and Elementary

- 1394 (IEP only)
- 553 (IEP + at-risk)
- 775 (IEP + handicap)
- Total: 2722
(12.9% of elementary students supported with an IEP)
(12.3% of elementary students have an IEP with an at-risk or handicap code)

Secondary:

- 1606 (IEP only)
- 1029 (IEP + at-risk)
- 664 (IEP + handicap)
- Total: 3299
(20.5% of secondary students supported with an IEP)
(21.7% of secondary students have an IEP with an at-risk or handicap code)
