LEAVE OF ABSENCE REQUESTS

This year there were 99 leave of absence requests. 79 were granted and 20 denied.

EXCESS

There were a total of 47 teachers placed on excess this year, with 5 of those being both school and board excess, and 9 being board excess. 38 are in elementary categories and 9 are in secondary categories. An information session was given on April 30 where the process was explained to all excess teachers. They then requested their preferred placement between April 30 and May 5.

It is important to note that E2 posts are not yet confirmed. Teachers in E2 posts are not a part of the excess process.
